

- 1. Place jet system into sink. Attach hose to faucet. NOTE: some faucets may require an adaptor (available at your home brew or hardware retailer).
- 2. Place 12 wine or beer bottles inverted into tray (12 bottles must be placed into tray. If washing less than 12 bottles, use clean bottles for the remaining spaces). Fits most popular sizes of bottles. If washing plastic bottles, place another full tray on top to hold bottles in place.
- 3.Lower tray onto jet system. Align the 2 red center pins with the guide holes in the tray. Fig. 1
- 4. Turn faucet on to begin washing bottles. Turn faucet off when washing is complete. Fig. 2

CAUTION: Do not use extremely hot

water for an extended length of time.

- 5. Lift tray from sink. Tilt tray slightly to drain excess water Fig. 3
- 6. Stack full trays for drying bottles. Fig. 4


