



Dear Valued Customer,

This is response to your recent request for Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for Briess Syrup, Extract or Liquid products.

Food grade products intended for edible uses do not require Safety Data Sheets to comply with OSHA regulation 29 CFR 1910.1200 "The Hazard Communication Standard."

Under the Standard, a SDS is only required for hazardous chemicals. Hazardous chemicals are defined as any chemical that is a physical or health hazard. Physical and health hazards are further defined and Appendix B of the Standard describes criteria used to determine whether or not a chemical is to be considered hazardous. Foods regulated under The Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (which all of our foods and food ingredients are) DO NOT meet any of the criteria that require them to be listed as hazardous. Therefore, Briess syrups, extracts and liquids DO NOT require a SDS.
